SCRAN ACADEMY EXISTS TO HELP YOUNG PEOPLE OVERCOME POVERTY-RELATED BARRIERS AND THRIVE THROUGH ACCESSING THE EXPERIENCES, SUPPORT, RELATIONSHIPS AND SKILLS REQUIRED TO CHANGE THEIR OWN LIVES.

WE OFFER TRANSFORMATIONAL YOUTH WORK, EDUCATION AND SOCIAL ENTERPRISE PROGRAMMES THAT EMPOWERS YOUNG PEOPLE TO FULFIL THEIR POTENTIAL.

'SCRAN' WAS FOUNDED IN 2017 BY PEOPLE FROM THE VERY COMMUNITIES IN WHICH WE WORK AND WITH DIRECT EXPERIENCE OF POVERTY, TRAUMA AND EXCLUSION.

BY TAKING AN OPTIMISTIC, ASSET-BASED AND NON-JUDGEMENTAL APPROACH, SCRAN CHALLENGES THE IDEA THAT IT IS INEVITABLE THAT CERTAIN YOUNG PEOPLE FROM CERTAIN PLACES WILL FAIL.



For many young people and families' across Edinburgh, times are extremely tough. They live in the least affordable local authority in Scotland, and despite huge areas of affluence, Edinburgh has the 4th highest level of child poverty nationally - with 1 in 5 children below the poverty line. This has been exacerbated by the covid19 lockdown and worsening cost of living crisis, but for many there has always been a cost of living crisis. Whilst we entered the pandemic unequal, we exit it even more unequal. The Edinburgh Poverty Commission identified that in the 5 years leading up to the pandemic, there was a 28% rise in children living in poverty and this is anticipated to continue to increase.

Living in poverty greatly increases the risk of exposure to traumatic experiences, educational disengagement and wider social exclusion. For young people it is a life of constant uncertainty and insecurity. Young people's core needs are unfulfilled, talents are left hidden, potential left unrealised, their voices ignored and basic rights undermined. We see a tightening benefit system that doesn't keep up with inflation, unmoving poverty-related attainment gap, social housing crisis, increasing drug and alcohol misuse and youth employment still way below that of employment generally. Literacy figures have fallen to 67% and numeracy figures fallen to 74% in school age children – these are even worse in areas of multiple deprivation. Public Health Scotland figures show that at the end of 2021, over 50% of young people referred to mental health support in Edinburgh were waiting over 18-weeks, with 1 in 5 waiting well over a year.

Frontline services like Scran see the direct impacts of this climate, not least around trauma and poor emotional wellness. Traumatic experiences can occur when young people feel rejected, unsafe, ashamed and powerless – so often caused by the wider impacts of poverty and isolation. Adverse Childhood Experiences affects how young people are equipped to respond to life, and often cause significant challenges such as maintaining relationships, holding down commitments or managing change. Without appropriate support, this leads to greater risk of economic inactivity, entering the criminal justice system, homelessness, serious health problems and living in long term poverty.



The published Scottish Government report "Young People's Experience of Education & Training from 15-24 years" highlighted the need for "tailored and intensive support" to young people, and also recommended "a greater focus on life skills" within education. This is the fundamental approach of Scran. Employers consistently highlight a lack of life skills, confidence and communication skills as gaps in new employees. There are an estimated 30,000 young people in Scotland not in education, training or employment. Over 60% of these young people have been identified as facing significant and multiple barriers to finding work including recently leaving care, mental and physical health challenges, homelessness, convictions or a lack of qualifications. For example research suggests 1 in 4 girls and 1 in 10 boys report being depressed.

Scran Academy is central to the political aspirations for young people, and our work sits alongside many policy priority areas, not least the recent Edinburgh Poverty Commission Report, Locality Improvement Plans and citywide Pupil Equity Framework ambitions. Furthermore, the Young People Guarantee, Developing the Young Workforce, igniting social enterprise models and closing the attainment gap in education remains the top policy priority for the Scottish Government. However local and national government policies and priorities are not the limits of our aspirations or priorities.






